Russian Jewry. A community on crossroads of times and civilizations w/ Yigal Kotler

The Russian Jewish community of today, that has spread all over the globe, represents a phenomenon that is founded in its rich heritage and originated in crossroads of cultures and political systems. Russian Jews experienced dramatic transitions, suffered from anti-Semitism and historical cataclysms, while at the same time struggling for their Jewish continuity. Russian Jewry today is quite visible in the world Jewish landscape, but still provokes numerous unanswered questions. The presentation is an interactive workshop aimed to explore the phenomenon of Russian Jews as a community.

Community Barometer. Creating our own measurements w/ Lisa Klig

In this entirely interactive workshop for adults, we will create our own community barometer to gauge the values, concerns, and interests of Mishpucha families gathered this weekend. See where you fall on the scale, and explore the context of the Russian-speaking Jewish community in the US today.

Values Casino w/ Lisa Klig Bid, negotiate, convince others that you're right! In this game for adults we'll explore what values we agree on and which ones we don't. Then we'll put them to the test and see if this has anything to do with being Jewish.

Fearless Flyers Learn to perform tricks on an Olympic trampoline! Participants will be taught how to flip in a safe environment, using a harness and overhead safety device. Likewise, Fearless Flyers will be teaching incredible stunts and exercises using aerial fabrics!

Circus Arts In our circus class, young participants will discover new talents and develop skills they can hone at home, like juggling scarves and balls, spinning poi, and balancing plates!

kidBILT Woodshops enable students to use real tools to work with wood, while exploring the fundamental concepts of math, geometry, physics and engineering. Boys and girls plan, measure and build 3D objects developing physical skills, spatial and mechanical reasoning, understanding of materials and conceptual thinking.
